Lesson Goals

- Understand the importance of open and honest conversation as a vehicle of discipleship to Gen Z.
- Recognize ways of approaching and creating the atmosphere for open and honest conversation.
- Recognize how Feed resources can help accomplish open and honest conversation with students.

Key Points

- Open, honest dialogue doesn't just lead to the connection Generation Z is looking for. It also is one of the best ways you can reach students with the truth of who Jesus is.
- Key ways to create open and honest dialogue:
 - o Structured small groups
 - o Don't just teach, talk (but mostly listen)
 - o Have fun together (outside of church too)
- Good leaders don't answer the hard questions; they facilitate discussion.
